
Revised statement developments Middle East

The ongoing tensions in the Middle East and high energy and fuel prices are putting pressure on commodities, packaging, and logistics. For the time being, we do not foresee any direct supply problems, as our main suppliers are based within Europe and our flows do not pass through the affected area. However, we remain alert to indirect effects such as higher energy prices, logistics surcharges, and supply chain disruptions.

To date, we have not passed on any fuel or transport surcharges, despite the provisions in our contracts that would allow us to do so. Given the continued increase in costs, we will introduce a transport surcharge effective April 20. The exact rate will be communicated shortly.

As long as the situation remains uncertain, we are monitoring the market closely and will share a brief weekly update on relevant developments and potential impact.
